

Worship Service

Sunday, May 7th, 2017

We are planning a unique service, a joint worship service with us, Iglesia Pent. Bajo el Abrigo Del Altisimo (Pastor Bermudez's congregation – worships in our Fellowship Hall) and Iglesia de Restauracion Unidas en Cristo (Pastor Gomez's congregation – worships in our upstairs).

Worship will begin at 10:45AM and conclude at 12 noon. This will be followed by a shared meal with all of us in the Fellowship Hall with all of our favorite dishes and desserts.

You might ask why – we have been leasing worship space to these churches for four years and consistory felt it was time we meet one another. We are three congregations meeting in one building, worshipping God.

This will be a bi-lingual service — meaning both Spanish and English will be spoken with a translator. Don't let that scare you. This will be a unique service, the first ever here where we will get a feel for how the others worship and give praise to God through the word and music.

Look for a sign-up sheet where you can sign-up and let us know what you will be bringing to share with our Spanish sister and brothers. All of us as Pastors are meeting and working together planning the service so all will know what is happening and feel welcome. We don't want anyone to feel left out or confused.

I know God's presence and the Holy Spirit is present in our worship and so do they. I am proud of our UCC congregation and church! Are you? Then join me on May 7th as we welcome and worship with our sisters and brothers in Christ. Let us practice what Jesus taught us — as we worship with those who are different and become one in our love for God and in our faithfulness.


Dear Friends,






