



#### Reflections From the Pastor...

Recently a member of our church texted me this question, "What Makes A Good Christian?". With prejudice, animosity, and the things going on in our world today, this is a topic I would like to use for our 1<sup>st</sup> Bible Study n' Lunch session on Wednesday, September 20, 2017 from 11:30AM-1:00PM. This will be a topic that we will look at personally, biblically and spiritually as a group.

If you have a special Bible you prefer, please bring it with you, otherwise we will have Bibles available for your use. Please bring a bag lunch and drink as well.

Harvest Home – where we will have a display of all your donated food, boxed and canned. Then after the 24<sup>th</sup> the food will be given to the food bank.


#### Sunday, October 1, 2017



The annual Fritz Trust Fund donation to St. James UCC was received July 15, 2017 - \$23,109.20. This donation was allocated as follows: \$5,000 - Boiler Heat Fund, \$5,000 - re-payment on the principal amount borrowed from The Cornerstone Fund, and \$13,109 to the General Fund. St. James UCC sincerely appreciates this generous gift to our church.




